

Smell the Sea, Feel the Sky 26 May – 5 July 2020

Postcard Exhibition 2020 Exploring and illustrating the moors, coast, town and villages in and around Whitby.

Artwork Submission

The Pannett Art Gallery invites artists to take part in our Postcard Exhibition, “**Smell the Sea, Feel the Sky**”, 26 May – 5 July 2020.

An eclectic mix of styles and artforms will create a vibrant exhibition that everyone can be a part of, combining the work of early career individuals with those of established artists. We will display as many artworks as possible as long as they are suitable for a family audience.

We will accept original artwork submissions of any medium, style and ability - they must fit the specified postcard size of 6 x 8 inches (15 x 20.5cm) and with a maximum depth of 5mm. Submitted artworks must not pose a safety risk and must not be considered offensive in terms of content, character denigration, racial or religious prejudice. Fragile artworks are entered at the artist's own risk. All suitable works received with a completed application form and checklist, by the deadline, will be accepted. Please read all submission details as failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions will make an entry ineligible.

Every artwork will be for sale during the exhibition, each priced at a set £20.00. The Pannett Art Gallery will take 30% commission (£6.00) on any artwork sold.

You can submit as many works as you like. If you submit more than one postcard we may not display them all in one go, but as works sell we will replace them with postcards held in reserve. Unsold artworks cannot be removed before the exhibition concludes.

Works should be unframed. We will be attaching them to the wall using White Tac or Glue dots. If this will be unsuitable for your artwork please contact the gallery.

Whether you submit one postcard or twenty a non-refundable payment of £2.00 is required to cover administration costs. Please attach a £2.00 coin to your application form. Cheques will not be accepted.

Delivering art work

The delivery of artworks is at no cost to the Pannett Art Gallery. Artworks can be delivered directly to the gallery. If submitting by post, please ensure the correct postage has been paid. The Gallery will not pay excess postage for the delivery/collection of postcards.

The deadline for entries is 4pm, Sunday 17th May 2020

The Pannett Art Gallery is not responsible for any late entries, or for any loss or damage caused to artworks while in transit to and from the gallery. Please allow sufficient time for postage. It is not possible to confirm receipt of entries submitted by post.

Return of unsold art work

Unsold work should be collected from the gallery within two weeks after the exhibition closes. Please let us know who will be collecting your work. Work can be returned by post by arrangement. If you require the return of any unsold work please supply suitable packaging

(cardboard envelope). Please allow up to six weeks for Pannett Art Gallery to return your work after the exhibition.

All submissions must be accompanied by a completed Submission Form and signed Check List

Please note:

Artists should send actual work (i.e. not photographs of other works), unframed.

Limited edition prints and photographs (where the photograph is considered to be the work itself) are both acceptable. We do not accept video or sculptural works. We may not be able to hang multiple artworks by one artist or a series of works together. Placement of artworks is at the Gallery's discretion.

Insurance against loss or damage to the work during transit and for the duration of the show is at the discretion of the artist and is the artist's responsibility to arrange. This is not the responsibility of Pannett Art Gallery to arrange, and while we take every care to look after your work while it is at the Gallery, Pannett Art Gallery will not be held responsible for any art works damaged during the exhibition.

Entrants agree to allow the Gallery to reproduce (at no charge) images of submitted artwork for press, marketing, publicity, and archiving purposes, including websites and social media sites. The Pannett Art Gallery will give a full image credit to the artist where possible. This does not affect the copyright status of the work.

All postcards will be for sale for £20.00. The gallery will take a 30% commission on each individual postcard sold (£6.00). All payment to artists for sold work are made by Bank Transfer (BACS). Please ensure you have supplied your bank details. Payments will be processed within six weeks of the end of the exhibition.
