

Open Exhibition – Call for submissions

One Small Step – How to Save the World

23 Aug – 9 October 2022



Artwork Submission

The Pannett Art Gallery invites you to create a Two Dimensional artwork illustrating one small adaptation to lifestyles, that people can easily adopt, to help to tackle climate change, reduce carbon emissions, or improve the environment. The action it is illustrating must be included, in legible text on the artwork, AND/OR in the title to be displayed alongside the picture in the gallery. The external dimensions of all artworks must be

A3 (297 x 420 mm / 29.7 x 42 cm / 11 ¾ x 16 ½ in)

or A4 (210 x 297 mm / 21 x 29.7 cm / 8 ¼ x 11 ¾ in)

with a maximum depth of 5mm.

An eclectic mix of styles and artforms will create a vibrant exhibition that everyone can be a part of, combining the work of early career individuals with those of established artists. We will display as many artworks as possible as long as they are suitable for a family audience. We encourage the use of recycled materials in the creation of artworks, which may include painting, printmaking, collage, embroidery, poetry, mixed media or other.

Artworks will be displayed at the Pannett Art Gallery 23 Aug – 9 October 2022.

From 1st July we will accept original artwork submissions of any medium, style and ability - they must fit the specified size of A4 or A3, with a maximum depth of 5mm. Submitted artworks must not pose a safety risk and must not be considered offensive in terms of content, character denigration, or prejudice. Fragile artworks are entered at the artist's own risk. We will accept up to three suitable works per artist. They must be accompanied by a completed application form and checklist, by the deadline, 7th August 2022. Please read submission details carefully as failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions will make an entry ineligible.

Works must be framed using standard A4 or A3 size frames. Framed works or unframed canvas must be ready for hanging, with D-rings or Screw Eyes attached.

The gallery has a small number of A4 and A3 frames, from previous exhibitions, which are available to be loaned, by arrangement. Please discuss this with the gallery before submitting unframed work.

If you chose to make your artwork available for sale during the exhibition, the Pannett Art Gallery will take 30% commission on the selling price of any artwork sold (divide artist price by 0.7 to reach the gallery selling price). Please state the artists price and the selling price (artists price plus gallery commission) on your submission form.

Eg.

Artist price (70%)	Gallery commission (30%)	Selling price (100%)

Delivering art work

The delivery of artworks is at no cost to the Pannett Art Gallery. From 1st July artworks can be delivered directly to the gallery.

When delivering or collecting artworks please consider sharing your journey with other local artists to reduce the environmental impact of travel to the gallery

The deadline for entries is 4pm, Sunday 7th August 2022

The Pannett Art Gallery is not responsible for any late entries, or for any loss or damage caused to artworks while in transit to and from the gallery.

It is not possible to confirm receipt of entries not delivered directly to the gallery.

Return of art work

After the exhibition unsold art work should be collected from the gallery within two weeks after the exhibition closes. Please let us know who will be collecting your work.

All submissions must be accompanied by a completed Submission Form and signed Check List

Please note:

Artists should send actual work (i.e. not photographs of other works), framed.

Limited edition prints and photographs (where the photograph is considered to be the work itself) are both acceptable. We do not accept video or sculptural works. We may not be able to hang multiple artworks by one artist or a series of works together. Placement of artworks is at the Gallery's discretion.

Insurance against loss or damage to the work during transit and for the duration of the show is at the discretion of the artist and is the artist's responsibility to arrange. This is not the responsibility of Pannett Art Gallery to arrange, and while we take every care to look after your work while it is at the Gallery, Pannett Art Gallery will not be held responsible for any art works damaged during the exhibition.

Entrants agree to allow the Gallery to reproduce (at no charge) images of submitted artwork for press, marketing, publicity, and archiving purposes, including websites and social media sites. The Pannett Art Gallery will give a full image credit to the artist where possible. This does not affect the copyright status of the work.
